The fathers' fear

Bastian Kraft stages *Idomeneo* by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, General Music Director Cornelius Meister conducts

In 2022, director **Bastian Kraft** created the successful Stuttgart production of *Rusalka*. Now he in back and together with his former production team, he puts Mozart's *Idomeneo* onto the stage. The new opera production premieres on 24 November under the musical direction of General Music Director **Cornelius Meister**. Tenor **Jeremy Ovenden** takes on the title role, Anett Fritsch the role of Idamante. Ensemble member and Kammersängerin **Diana Haller** sings Elettra, **Lavinia Bini** Ilia and **Charles Sy** Arbace.

In his opera *Idomeneo*, Mozart combined the various French and Italian operatic traditions of his time. With great virtuosity, he composed and put together the arias and pieces of chorus in order to create a larger scenic context: After returning home from the Trojan War, King Idomeneo finds himself in an adverse situation. Whilst caught on sea in a terrible storm, he promised his own son Idamante as sacrifice to the god Poseidon, should they all be saved in time.

Director Bastian Kraft stages the opera as a reflection on the **fathers' fear of their own sons**, the traces of the archaic within European civilization, the rebellion of nature as well as the generational conflicts. Kraft and his team create a scenic space that allows the characters to interact with their own **inner demons and dream figures** via **shadow projections**. Mozart's *Idomeneo* was last put to the Stuttgart stage in 2008.
